William Keohane is a writer from Limerick, Ireland, whose essays and poetry have been published in The Stinging Fly, The Dublin Review, Poetry Ireland Review, and Queering the Green, an anthology of post-2000 queer Irish poetry.

In Vienna, he will be performing an abridged version of Boxing Day, a series of box-shaped poems exploring transition, confinement, and time, which he has been touring for the past three years. He will also read from Queering the Green as well as talk about trans writing and form.
